OPERATION ICECAP - EQUIPMENT LIST

Winter camping in Manitoba requires that special care and attention is paid to clothing. The list below is the **MINIMUM** recommended clothing list.

Leaders are responsible for the safety and comfort of your child this weekend. Camp Administration cannot allow any youth to go to camp who does not have the minimum recommended clothing list.

Scouts Canada's By-Laws, Policies and Procedures specifies that each youth's gear must be checked before it is packed in a vehicle.

<u>Note:</u> ANY PERSON WHO DOES NOT HAVE THE MINIMUM RECOMMEDED CLOTHING LIST WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN SOME CAMP EVENTS.

Minimum Required Clothing & Equipment List

Full Uniform 2 extra pairs of light socks

3-4 pairs heavy socks 2 thermal T-shirts 2 pairs thermal long johns 2 long-sleeved shirts

2 pairs of warm pants 1 pair of snow pants and parka

2 extra pairs of underpants 1 toque (2 if possible)
1 pair of winter boots (2 if possible) 2 pairs of warm mitts
1 scarf (2 if possible) 1 pair of indoor shoes

2 pairs of pajamas Extra pair of sweats – backup spare.

Other:

- Sleeping Bag
- Pillow
- Flashlight
- Wash-up Kit—Toothbrush and paste, Face cloth and towel, Soap, Comb, Kleenex)
- Swimming suit and towel
- Extra Light-Colored T-shirt for Silk Screening
- Extra blanket (optional)

**** Please label all clothing and equipment. Helps to ensure lost items are returned.

ALL MEALS AND SNACKS ARE PROVIDED BY CAMP ARNES.

- Specialty food for dietary restrictions can be dropped off Camp Arnes kitchen staff for storage. Medical forms should list allergies and dietary requirements.
- No food or drinks are allowed in the cabins. Do not bring any extra food.
- Youth medications are to be managed by group's leaders or attending parents.

<u>Note:</u> Electronics are not permitted at camp (accept personal cameras). Youth Cellphone's as cameras are not acceptable. Leader phones on vibrate at all times.
